

God created each of us with a specific will unique to our identity in Christ. We are to seek out His will that awaits each of us to exercise. We should “walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God” (Col 1:10). It is by our increasing knowledge of God and faith that we can identify and focus our will to serve our Father in Heaven with impact.

- Eph 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
- Rom 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- 2 Tim 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- Titus 2:12 teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,
- 2 Cor 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit *be* with you all. Amen.
- John 3:30 He must increase, but I *must* decrease.
- 1 John 4:4 You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
